- All the applicants have to register at the website of the University of Calicut at <https://admission.uoc.ac.in/> under the Centralized Admission Process and obtain the CAP ID.
- The CAP registration is mandatory for all applications.
- Candidates provisionally selected for admission will be called for an interview. (No information will be sent to the candidates who have not been selected for the interview).
- For admission to the M.A. Journalism and Mass Communication and MSW (Master of Social Work) programme the student has to appear for the Entrance examination conducted by the College.

12. Two copies of recent Passport-Size Photograph

■ FEE PAYMENT AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

The candidate should remit the Semester Tuition Fee after the interview.

The rates are as provided in Government Order (Ms.) No. 209/2013/H.Edn. dated 29.5.2013 and the University Order No. 1995/2013/CU dated 7.6.2013 and are subject to changes depending on the direction from the Government/University on the fee structure for self-financing colleges.

If any candidate who is provisionally selected fails to report on or before the specified date and time or if he/she fails to pay the prescribed fees, his/her selection will stand cancelled.

FEE REMITTANCE

The Tuition Fee for the semester is to be remitted. The Hostel Fee and Transportation Fee is to be paid at the beginning of every term in June, October and January if the facility is availed.

INFRASTRUCTURE

LIBRARY COMPLEX

The library is the hub of activities of any academic institution. The Institute has an excellent Library and Information Centre. The library is digitalised with access to eBooks and eJournals with a well-established repository. The library has computerised its operations and services with standard software.

HOSTELS

The Institute provides hostels for girls and boys in the campus for a prescribed fee, which is fixed by the Management. The hostels are set in a picturesque atmosphere with all the modern amenities. Application forms for admission to the hostel are to be submitted at the time of admission.

TRANSPORTATION

Bus facility is provided from the following places to the Institution on a payment basis, which is subject to revision: Ramanattukara, Feroke, Calicut, Kondotty and Edavannapara.

CULTURAL CENTRE

The campus has a beautifully built Cultural Centre for prayer and meditation, with separate floors for boys and girls. The Cultural Centre will be holding classes and discussions on ethical and moral values to help the students develop leadership qualities. In a serene ambience, it boosts academic culture as well.



SPORTS & GAMES

Keeping good physical fitness is also as important as nurturing the brain with intellectual activities. The Institute emphasises the need to participate in sports and games and other physical activities. Besides the facilities for games like basketball, volleyball, football, cricket, shuttle, badminton, handball, softball, baseball, and table tennis, amenities such as a physical fitness centre, yoga centre, and martial arts centre are also provided.

REPROGRAPHIC FACILITY

The Library offers reprographic services and is equipped with the most modern photocopying machine.

ATM with a cash deposit facility is provided on the campus to cater to the needs of the Institute community.

STATIONERY STORE

The Institute runs a small store with the daily necessities and stationery items for the convenience of the students.

DISCIPLINARY NORMS

All students admitted to the Institution shall observe the rules and regulations of the Institute. Any kind of disturbing behaviour or causing damage to the college/public property on the campus is strictly forbidden. Any violation of these rules will result in disciplinary action, including dismissal.

ACTION AGAINST RAGGING

In accordance with UGC Draft Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, ragging in any form is strictly forbidden. Ragging of any nature is a non-bailable offence and will have to face criminal procedure. If any incident of ragging and/or of abetting ragging by any student comes to the notice of the authority, it will be immediately reported to the Police.

CELLPHONES

Use of cell phones by students on campus at any time and in any place is banned. Violation of this rule will result in confiscation of the phone and levying of fines.

DRESS CODE

Students are expected to wear clean, simple, modest and formal dress to college.

DISCONTINUING THE PROGRAMME

The enrolled students are expected to complete their course of study. They may not withdraw from the Institute without informing the Principal in writing, otherwise, they will be liable to pay the fee of the period for which their names remain on the roll.

LEADERS ACADEMY

The mission of Leaders' Academy is to enable the students to prepare themselves to become socially responsible leaders who can bring about constructive change in society.

SAFI CIVIL SERVICES CENTRE

The SAFI Civil Services Centre has been launched at the SAFI campus in January 2022. It offers civil services coaching to a maximum of 100 students per year. The programme is fully residential and also offers scholarships to the eligible candidates.

PMA SAFI HUMAN RESOURCES INSTITUTE

The PMA SAFI Human Resources Institute in the campus offers one-year certificate programmes in Social Enterprises Management, Public Policy Management and two-year diploma programme in Management recognised by AICTE.
